Tournament Details

- The tournament will comprise of seven divisions with room for four teams in each division.
- The divisions will include:
 - 4th-6th grade boys
 - 4th-6th grade girls
 - 7th-8th grade boys
 - 7th-8th grade girls
 - 9-12 grade boys
 - 9-12 grade girls
 - Adult Co-ed (An adult co-ed team must include one female playing at all times.)
- A player can play “up” a grade, but not down. i.e. a 6th grader could play in the 7th & 8th grade division, but a 7th grader could not play in the 4th-6th grade division.
- The first four teams to register in any given division will be entered into the tournament.
- Should any division have less than four teams registered, there may be room for another division to have more than four teams.
- Each team will play all the other teams in their division, for a minimum of three games.
- A final “championship” game will be played by the top two teams in each division. (Official tie-breaker rules will be made known to registered teams prior to the tournament.)
- Each division’s games will be clustered into a block of the schedule, not scattered throughout the day. This includes the championship game. (The official tournament schedule will be available to the registered teams five to seven days prior to the tournament.)
- To accommodate this twenty-eight team tournament which will involve forty-nine games on two available courts, games will need to be fairly short, with new games beginning every 20 minutes. Games will be played to a certain number of points (still to be determined), or a maximum of 15 minutes per game.
- Division Champions are invited to be recognized at the Winter Pine Fest closing ceremonies to be held at 4:30 pm at the Lake Ann United Methodist Church Education Center.
- The registration deadline will be Friday, February 16th. **Only the first four teams** to register in each division will be entered. Should the schedule allow, teams beyond the initial four teams in each division will be notified shortly after the registration deadline.
